- As members, we are self-reliant in our various homes in different capacities due to the income
  we got from selling produce realized during your support
- Other group members are involved in small scale vegetable gardening that sustains them with daily income.

- Unreliable weather to sustain vegetable gardening and other agricultural activities.
- Pest and diseases that affects the crops due to weather changes and animal diseases (Piggery) as well.
- All the above activities are being done in small scale and sustainability is difficult due to unreliability in the economy.

## **FUTURE PLANS**

To continue with farming but in large scale especially growing maize in large scale and supplying o schools around.

Opening a piggery farm to help boast income because it attracts a lot of money for example a piglet goes for one hundred to two hundred thousand shillings depending on the breed.

Acquiring a maize milled so we can sell already milled maize.

Opening a poultry farm on a large scale to benefit all group members.
